 - When registering for electronic filing through the <u>Pacer Service Center</u>, two options are available to control frequency of notification, 'Each Transaction' or 'Daily Summary', however, due to processing restrictions, only 'Each Transaction' is offered by the Fifth Circuit. If 'Daily Summary' is selected when registering through Pacer, we will reset it to reflect 'Each Transaction' when processing your request to become an electronic filer.
 - email format options HTML or plain text (depending upon your emailprogram)
 - passwords must be 8 14 characters and contain at least 2 nonalphacharacters; you can enter a password of your choosing or allow the system to generate one for you.
