
MEMORANDUM

Complainant, a *pro se* civil litigant, protests that by dismissing his appeal for lack of jurisdiction, the three subject United States Circuit Judges “deni[ed] my right to appeal of the arbitrary transfer of my complaint and the summery [sic] dismissal of my TRO. ... 5th [sic] Order should have redirected my case back to [the district court]!”

The complaint relates directly to the merits of the judges’ decision, and is therefore subject to dismissal under 28 U.S.C. § 352(b)(1)(A)(ii).

Judicial misconduct proceedings are not a substitute for the normal appellate review process, nor may they be used to obtain reversal of a decision or a new trial.

An order dismissing the complaint is entered simultaneously herewith.
