MEMORANDUM

Complainant, an attorney, has filed a complaint of judicial disability against the subject United States District Judge who recently became an inactive senior judge.

To the extent that complainant submits that "any and all Orders issued" in a particular civil proceeding "are invalid, and must be rescinded," the complaint procedures are not a substitute for the normal appellate review process, nor may they be used to obtain reversal of a decision or a new trial.

Under 28 U.S.C. § 352(b)(2), the proceeding may be concluded if appropriate corrective action has been taken or action on the complaint is no longer necessary because of intervening events. I find that this proceeding should be concluded under this subsection.

An order concluding this proceeding is entered simultaneously herewith.
