MEMORANDUM


On September 26, 2019, the Clerk docketed a judicial misconduct complaint filed by attorney complainant against the subject United States District Judge. On October 3, 2019, complainant submitted a written request to withdraw the complaint pursuant to Rule 27(a) of the Rules for Judicial-Conduct and Judicial-Disability Proceedings.

Rule 27(a) provides:

With the chief judge's consent, the complainant may withdraw a complaint that is before the chief judge for a decision under Rule 11. The withdrawal of a complaint will not prevent the chief judge from identifying or having to identify a complaint under Rule 5 based on the withdrawn complaint.

Complainant's request to withdraw the complaint is GRANTED.

I decline to identify a complaint under Rule 5, and an order concluding the complaint under 28 U.S.C. § 352(b)(2) is entered simultaneously herewith.
