MEMORANDUM

Complainant, a pro se litigant, has filed a complaint alleging misconduct by the three subject United States Circuit Judges.

Complainant complains that the judges "did not deny me my Social Security but just said they agreed with how the U.S. Railroad Retirement Board calculated my retirement, I did not ask that question, I was filing for Social [Security] and Discrimination. If they did not give me either, then they are discriminating against me."

The complaint relates directly to the merits of a decision or procedural ruling and is therefore subject to dismissal under 28 U.S.C. § 352(b)(1)(A)(ii).

Judicial misconduct proceedings are not a substitute for the normal appellate review process, nor may they be used to obtain reversal of a decision or a new trial.

An order dismissing the complaint is entered simultaneously herewith.
